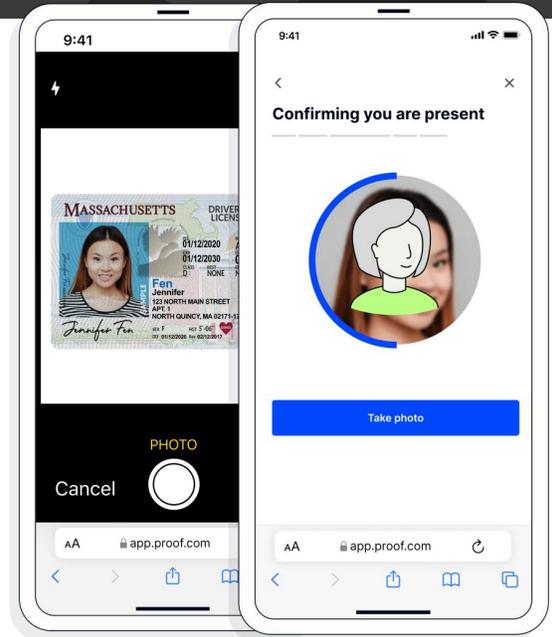

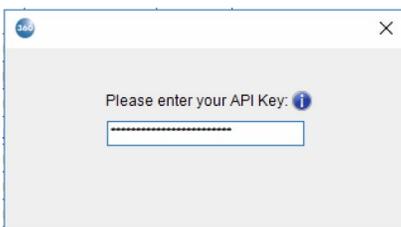


Getting Started with Identify

Step 1

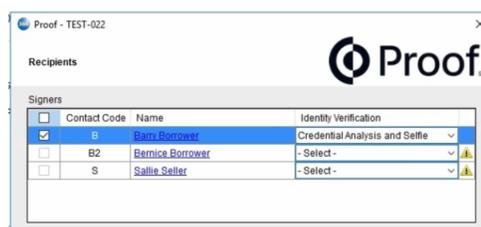
Integrate with SoftPro
